This annual report has been developed by Jones College in accordance with the requirements of the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act).

In accordance with Clery Act regulations, Jones College has several obligations in the areas of information, disclosure and dissemination. These obligations fall into three main categories: 1) policy disclosure; 2) records collection and retention; and 3) information dissemination. Jones College complies with Clery Act requirements at both campus locations.

1. Policy Disclosure

Jones College must provide the campus community and the public with accurate statements of its current policies and practices regarding:

Procedures for students and others to report criminal actions or other emergencies occurring on campus.

Security of and access to campus facilities.

Campus law enforcement.

2. Records Collection and Retention

Jones College is required to keep records of reportable crimes and to request records from law enforcement agencies.

3. Information Dissemination

Jones College is required to provide campus community members with information necessary to make informed decisions about their safety.
