

Public Disclosure of Student Achievement

Retention Rate: Retention is reported based upon the total enrollment and withdrawals during the specified reporting period.

- A. **Retention Rate Formula:** Retention percentage rate = $(A-B)/A$
A = Beginning enrollment (currently enrolled students), plus Re-Entries (returning students), plus New Starts (new students)
B = Withdrawals: a student who is no longer enrolled at the Institution and
- (1) Has failed to attend the full length of the program
 - (2) Has not maintained satisfactory academic progress
 - (3) Has failed courses
 - (4) Has not attained speeds or competencies required
 - (5) Is not eligible for a credential; or
 - (6) Failed to meet the institution's attendance and/or graduation requirements

- B. **Sample Calculation:** Beginning enrollment for period: 700 students
Re-Entry Students: 100 students
New Enrollments: 200 students
Withdrawals: 250 students

$$\text{Retention rate} = [(700+100+200) - 250] / (700+100+200)$$

$$\text{Retention rate} = [1000-250] / 1000$$

$$\text{Retention rate} = 750/1000$$

$$\text{Retention rate} = 75\%$$

West Campus Retention Rate

July 2010 – June 2011: 69.1%

Placement Rate: Institutions report placement outcomes for graduates and completers as of the submission date of the Campus Accountability Report.

- A. Placement Rate Formula:** Placement percentage rate = $(PF+PR)/(G-U)$
PF= Graduates placed in field
PR = Graduates placed in a related field
G = Graduates and Completers
U = Unavailable for placement

Completer: A student who is no longer enrolled and who has either completed the time allowed or has attempted the maximum allowable number of credits for the program of study and did not meet ACICS or college mandated graduation standards (for example, a graduate who did not have the minimum required grade point average).

Unavailable for placement: graduate who unavailable for placement because of pregnancy or other health related situation, is continuing his/her education, is on active military service, or is a foreign national who attended on an F-1 student visa.

- B. Sample Calculation:**
- Graduates: 200
Graduates placed in field: 75
Graduates placed in a related field: 75
Graduates employed out of field: 20
Completers: 10
Unavailable for placement: 10
- Placement rate = $(75 + 75) / (210-10)$
Placement rate = $150 / 200$
Placement rate = 75%

On-Time Completion Rate: This rate reflects the percent of graduates between August 31, 2010, and April 30, 2011 who completed their program within 100 percent of the normal timeframe as described as completing an associate degree within two years and a bachelor degree within four years.
